

AHA COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Healthcare Provider CPR Course:

Initial: \$16.00 In-State Volunteer Fire/Ambulance Companies/Police Agencies
\$55.00 All Others, includes book and pocket mask

Re-certification: \$16.00 In-State Volunteer Fire/Ambulance Companies/Police Agencies
\$ 5.00 In-State Volunteer Fire/Ambulance Companies/Police Agencies with Libraries
\$40.00 All others

Initial course 5 hours; Re-certification course 3 hours

Minimum number of students required: 8

This course is designed to teach skills and knowledge of adult one- and two-man CPR, pediatric CPR, AED and the management of the choking patient. This course requires the successful completion of a written and skills evaluation. This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations, or any Healthcare Provider. A course completion card is issued for this course with re-certification every two-years. This course is the mandatory certification for all Delaware First Responders and EMT-Basics.

Minimum number of students required: 8

This course instructs the students in the theory and operation of the automatic external defibrillator (AED) device and adult CPR and Choking and taught in the following categories: Adult AED, CPR and Choking, Pediatric AED, CPR and Choking, or Adult and Pediatric AED, CPR and Choking. This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations and must manage the patient until Basic Life Support and/or the paramedics arrive. This course requires the successful completion of a skill evaluation. A course completion card is issued for this course with a re-certification period every two years.

All Friends and Family courses include the book and pocket mask

Minimum number of students required: 8

This course teaches lay-rescuer skills in CPR and relief of choking in adults, children, and infants –plus child-safety strategies—to everyone from schoolchildren to adults and people at risk of sudden cardiac death. No certification card is issued for this course

All Friends and Family courses include the book

Minimum number of students required: 8

This course covers First Aid for children and is designed for mass-and community- based training of laypeople preparing them to administer basic first aid to children until professional help arrives on scene. No certification card is issued for this course.

Minimum number of students required: 8

This course is designed to teach rescuers the knowledge and psychomotor skills they need to recognize emergencies and give first aid. The first aid section covers general principles, medical emergencies, injuries, and environmental emergencies. The CPR section covers Adult CPR and choking, and the AED covers theory and operation of the AED. This course is taught in the following categories: First Aid, or First Aid and CPR and/or AED. Successful completion requires passing a written and skills evaluation. A course completion card is issued for this course with re-certification every two years.

First Aid course for children \$70.00 All First Aid courses include the book

Minimum number of students required: 8

Provides information on how to manage illness and injury in a child during the first few minutes of an emergency until professional help arrives. Includes four core modules: First Aid Basics, Injuries and Illnesses, Life-Threatening Emergencies and the Chain of Survival, and CPR and AED. Also includes optional modules, such as use of a nebulizer to meet regulations for day-care center in certain states.
