HEARTSAVER AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED) COURSE (4 HOURS) TC/RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course instructs the student in the theory and operation of automatic external defibrillator (AED) devices and adult CPR.

CONTENT: This course can be taught in module format to include one or all three of the following topics: Adult CPR, FBAO and Adult AED; Child CPR, FBAO and Child AED; Infant CPR and FBAO.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations and must manage the patient until pre-hospital units arrive or the patient can be transferred to individuals with more advanced levels of training.

PREREQUISITES: Attendee must be a member in good standing of an EMS, rescue, fire, or related organization.

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 10; Maximum of 35 students

EMS CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS IS

PURPOSE: These courses provide the student with basic life support skills and knowledge. Topics deal with EMS related issues.

CONTENT: Courses are specific to EMS issues.

AUDIENCE: Pre-hospital personnel

PREREQUISITES: Course Specific

CLASS LIMITS: None

EMT-B REFRESHER (24 HOURS) TC/RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course is to re-verify the skills and knowledge of the State and/or National Registry Basic Emergency Medical Technicians.

CONTENT: This course consists of airway management, trauma management, medical emergencies, emergency operations, patient assessment, obstetrics, and pediatrics.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for any individual currently certified as a State or Nationally Registered EMT.

PREREQUISITES: Must hold a current EMT-B certification, AHA Healthcare Provider card or equivalent and an AHA AED certification or equivalent.

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 8; Maximum of 35 students

FIRST RESPONDER COURSE (40 HOURS) TC/ RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course is to provide the student with the basic life support skills and knowledge to assess, stabilize, and monitor the pre-hospital patient. This course prepares the student to take the National Registry First Responder Exam and if successfully completed, obtain a First Responder Certification with a two year renewal option.

CONTENT: This course consists of airway management, CPR, AED, trauma management, medical emergencies, emergency operations, obstetrics, and pediatrics.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations and must manage the patient until pre-hospital units arrive or the patient can be transferred to individuals with more advanced levels of training.

CERTIFICATION: Personnel successfully completing the First Responder Course may be certified as a First Responder for a two (2) year period.

PREREQUISITES: Must be at least 16 years of age

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 8; Maximum of 35 students

FIRST RESPONDER REFRESHER (12 HOURS) TC/ RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course is to re-verify the skills and knowledge of the National Registry First Responder in the areas of First Aid, CPR and AED.

CONTENT: This course consists of airway management, CPR, AED, trauma management, medical emergencies, emergency operations, obstetrics, and pediatrics.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for any individual currently certified as a First Responder.

CERTIFICATION: Personnel successfully completing the First Responder Refresher Course may be recertified as a First Responder for a two (2) year period.

PREREQUISITES: Must hold a current First Responder certification

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 8; Maximum of 35 students

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER CPR (5 HOURS) RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course is designed to teach skills and knowledge of adult one- and two-man CPR, pediatric CPR, AED and management of the choking pediatric and adult patient. This course requires the successful completion of a written and skills evaluation.

CONTENT: This course covers CPR (Adult, Child and Infant), AED, and FBAO are covered in this course.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations, or any HealthCare Provider. This is the mandatory course for all certified First Responders and EMT-B's in the State of Delaware.

PREREQUISITES: Attendee must be a member in good standing of an EMS, rescue, fire, or related organization.

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 10; Maximum of 35 students

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER CPR RECERTIFICATION (3 HOURS) RC/IS

PURPOSE: This course is designed to re-verify skills and knowledge of adult one- and two-man CPR, pediatric CPR, AED and management of the choking pediatric and adult patient.

CONTENT: CPR, AED and airway management.

AUDIENCE: Any individual currently Healthcare Provider certified is encouraged to attend.

PREREQUISITES: Must be a member in good standing of an EMS, rescue, fire, or related organization and hold a current Healthcare Provider certification.

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 10; Maximum of 35 students

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC COURSE (140 hours) TC/RC

PURPOSE: This course meets and/or exceeds DOT emergency medical technician guidelines. The curriculum will prepare the student to take the National Registry Emergency Medical Technician – Basic exam, and if successfully completed, obtain an NREMT-B Certification with a two year renewal option.

CONTENT: This course provides the student with in-depth knowledge and skill-based training to appropriately assess, stabilize, monitor, and transport the pre-hospital patient.

AUDIENCE: This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations and must manage, treat, and transport the patient to an appropriate medical facility.

PREREQUISITES: Healthcare Provider CPR or equivalent with a module on AED, and must be at least 18 years of age. Individuals attending this course will be REQUIRED to have a background check completed prior to certification.

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 12; Maximum of 36 students

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION FIRST AID (4 HOURS) IS

PURPOSE: This course is designed to teach students basic first aid skills and knowledge to assess, stabilize and monitor the pre-hospital patient.

CONTENT: This course covers general principles, medical emergencies, injury emergencies and environmental emergencies. CPR/AED is an optional module to this course.

AUDIENCE: Any individual wanting to learn Basic First Aid.

PREREQUISITES: None

CLASS LIMITS: Minimum of 10; Maximum of 35 students
